## RAPID INTERVENTION TEAM

This course will present classroom lessons and hands-on skills needed to familiarize the firefighters with the Rapid Intervention Team procedures. Topics will be based upon NFPA 1407 and 1500. The class will include the procedures for firefighters rescuing a downed firefighter, as well as the incident command procedures needed for this type of incident. There will be hands-on skills for both firefighters and incident commanders on Saturday, February 4. Firefighters **MUST BE 18 YEARS OLD** to attend the Saturday training due to the IDLH atmosphere that the training will be held in. Everyone that participates in the skills portion **MUST** be clean shaved, have a SCBA with extra bottle, full turn-out gear, and a hard working attitude. This will be a very demanding but rewarding class.

Attendance at EACH classroom session is expected to participate in the skills session!
